PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

Over 35 years, doctor Labrecque carried on an active academic career in Family Medicine and Maternal and Child Health Care. He detains a strong expertise as a **clinician** (obstetrical and pediatric care, and family planning), a **teacher**, and a **researcher**. In 2014, Dr Labrecque was awarded the title of Researcher of the Year of the College of Family of Canada. Furthermore, in 2015, he was recognized as one of the 20 pioneers of Family Medicine Research in Canada for his outstanding work on male sterilisation.

He was the first Canadian physicians to practice the **No-scalpel Vasectomy**, performing more than 29 000 such procedures and providing hands-on training to over 50 physicians from all over the world since 1992.

In 2014, he created a specific fund, the *Michel Labrecque Fund for Male Reproductive Health*, within the Laval University Foundation. This fund aims to financially support research and education related to male reproductive health services in developing countries.

Dr Labrecque is currently sitting on **4 national and international committees** and chaired or participated to **89 committees** over the years. He acted as a reviewer for the National Health Research and Development Program (external), the Medical Research Council of Canada/Canadian Institutes of Health Research (both external and internal – clinical trial 2003-2004 and 2004-2005), and the *Fonds de recherche en santé du Québec* (both external and internal). He was the first President of the Section of Researchers from the College of Family Physicians of Canada and the Chair of the Task Force on the Future of Research in Family Medicine in Canada.

In 2002, Dr Labrecque chaired the organization of **Male Contraception: A Changing World**, a national symposium presented at the Forum 2002 of the College of Family Physicians of Canada in Montreal, Canada. From 2009 to 2012, he was invited to sit on the **AUA (American Urological Association) guideline committee on vasectomy**; he was the only non-US physician sitting on the committee. He was also invited as an external reviewer of the European Association

of Urology (EAU) Guidelines on Vasectomy in 2012 and of the Faculty of Sexual & Reproductive Healthcare (FSRH) guidance on Male and Female Sterilisation from UK in 2014. In 2011, he was sat on the *Ordre professionnel des technologistes médicaux du Québec* Guideline Committee on semen analysis. He is currently a member of the board of the **World Vasectomy Day** and of **No Scalpel Vasectomy International**.
